#### **DEVELOPMENT OF TOURISM IN NALANDA**

#### †433. SHRI KAUSHALENDRA KUMAR:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned funds for integrated development of Ghoda-Katora-Rajgir-Jal Mandu-Pawapuri located in Nalanda;
- (b) if so, the amount released to the State Government during the last five years;
- (c) whether the Government is contemplating to provide any other form of assistance for the development of Ghoda-Katora so as to develop this famous tourist site and attract more and more tourists; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI K. J. ALPHONS)

- (a) and (b): Yes, Madam. The Ministry of Tourism in the year 2013-14 has sanctioned an amount of Rs.4841 lakh for Integrated Development of Ghora Katora (Rajgir-Jalmandir-Pawapuri) as Mega Circuit in Bihar. An amount of Rs.968.35 lakh has been released to the State Government of Bihar for the project.
- (c) and (d): Development and promotion of **Tourism Destinations** primarily the responsibility of the State is **Territory (UT) Governments/Union** Administrations. However. Ministry of Tourism provides Central Financial Assistance (CFA) to State Governments/UT Administrations for various tourism projects subject to submission of Detailed **Project Reports** availability of funds, liquidation of pending utilization certificates against the funds released earlier and adherence to the relevant scheme guidelines.
