### FIXING OF PRICES OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

### Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has received complaints of inappropriate decisions taken by the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) with respect to fixing prices of petrol and diesel in the country since deregulation of their prices, if so, the details thereof along with the role of the Government to keep a check on the wrong fixation of prices of petrol and diesel by OMCs in the country;, State/ UT/OMC-wise;

(b) whether the Government has conducted any study to ascertain the impact of such inappropriate decisions on the profits of the said companies and on the common people, if so, the details and outcome thereof;

(c) whether the customers/consumers of petrol and diesel are not given the actual benefit that accrued to oil companies by importing the same at low prices and if so, the details thereof along with the corrective measures taken/proposed to be taken by the Government so that benefit of the same reaches to the consumers also;

(d) whether the Government is aware of the problems being faced by people due to fluctuations/frequent/daily changes in the prices of petroleum products since de-controlled by the Government and if so, the details thereof along with its likely impact on the common man, inflation/ essential commodities;

(e) the revenue, profit earned and dividends generated and paid by public sector oil companies from the sale of petrol, diesel, LPG in India and abroad during the last three years and the current year; and

(f) the barrel-wise price of various petroleum products in international market and their corresponding per barrel selling price in Indian market during the said period?

## MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a): The prices of Petrol and Diesel have been made market determined by the Government effective from  $26^{th}$  June, 2010 and  $19^{th}$  October, 2014 respectively and since then their prices are being decided by the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) in line with the changes in the international market prices. The Public Sector OMCs increase and decrease the prices on the basis of the price of respective products in the international market and not to that of crude oil.

(b) & (c): IOCL has informed that daily changes in pricing have actually benefitted the customers at large with several of the problems that were faced earlier have been resolved:

- i. During fortnightly pricing, there used to be huge queues at the Retail Outlets causing immense trouble to the customers. The same has been reduced.
- ii. Due to heavy rush of customers, product at several Retail Outlets used to get exhausted leaving the needy customers without fuel. The same has been reduced.
- iii. The revision of fuel prices are carried out every day based on the International prices and therefore any drop in prices are passed on to the customers.

(d): Public Sector OMCs, namely, Indian Oil Corporation Limited, Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited and Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited have implemented daily revision of retail selling price of Petrol and Diesel in the entire country effective 16th June, 2017.

Daily price revisions of Petrol and Diesel make the retail prices more reflective of the current market conditions, minimizing the volatility in the RSP of Petrol and Diesel. Further, it leads to increased transparency in the system and enables smoother flow of products from refinery/depots to Retail Outlets

(e): The total revenue, Profit after Tax and dividends of the OMCs from all activities including sale of Petrol, Diesel and LPG during the last three years and current year is given as under:-
