SHRI RAM CHARITRA NISHAD:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that the Government has launched a liveability index which will rank the country's 116 major cities on the basis of the quality of life they offer and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the liveability index is likely to cover cities with population above one million, including the capital cities and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the said ranking is likely to be released in 2018?

ANSWER

- (a) : Yes, Madam. It is true that the Government has launched a liveability index which will rank the country's 116 major cities on the basis of the quality of life they offer. The details of the same has been enclosed as Annexure-I.
- (b) : City liveability index will cover all Capital cities , 45 Million plus cities and some other cities. The details of the same has been enclosed as Annexure-II.
- (c) : Yes Madam. The said ranking is likely to be released in 2018.

LIVEABILITY STANDARDS IN CITIES

The Government of India along with the various State and Local Governments is implementing several flagship Urban Missions. An overarching goal of the various missions and schemes is to make Indian cities more 'Liveable'. In order to develop a common minimum framework for cities to assess their existing status and chart their pathway towards providing a better quality of life to their citizens, the Ministry of Urban Development has developed a set of 'Liveability Standards in Cities' to generate a Liveability Index and rate cities.

The framework has its genesis in the 24 Smart City features contained in the Smart City Proposals and includes 79 indicators (57 Core Indicators and 22 Supporting Indicators). These indicators are organised in 15 distinct 'Categories', designed for measuring various institutional, social, economic and physical aspects that affect the quality of life of citizens and determine the 'Liveability' of a city. These are given below:

The Liveability Standards framework enables the calculation of sub-indexes for each of the 15 Categories, allowing cities to assess their performance in specific categories and for planning improvements in the gap areas. Such Sub-indexes will be aggregated to a common 'City Liveability Index' for each city on the 79 indicators, based on specific weights assigned to the various Categories depending upon the pillar of comprehensive development.

The Ministry has already initiated process for selecting a professional agency to prepare the liveability index.
