Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently approved changes to ongoing central scheme Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) with a focus on value chain, post-harvest infrastructure and agri entrepreneur development among others, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has also rebranded RKVY as Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana-Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied Sector Rejuvenation (RKYY-RAFTAAR), if so, the details thereof along with the salient features of the scheme;
- (c) whether this scheme will make farming remunerative economic activity by strengthening farmer's effort, risk mitigation and promoting agri-business entrepreneurship, if so, the details thereof:
- (d) whether any budget allocation has also been made by the Government for the scheme, if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the manner in which the farmers will be benefited therefrom?

## **ANSWER**

- (a) to (d): Yes, Madam. RKVY has been revamped with effect from 1.11.2017 as Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied sector Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR) with the objective of making farming a remunerative economic activity through strengthening the farmer's effort, risk mitigation and promoting agri-business entrepreneurship with focus on development of pre and post harvest infrastructure. The aim is also to promote value chain linked production and public-private partnership in agriculture. The outlay approved for the programme for implementation during 2017-18 to 2019-20 is Rs.15722 crore. Budget allocation for implementation of the scheme for 2017-18 is Rs.4750 crore.
- (e): The revised scheme envisages promotion of agri-entrepreneurship and strengthening creation of agriculture infrastructure creating market linkages, enhancing productivity etc.

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
