DIGITAL EMPLOYMENT EXCHANGE

Will the **PRIME MINISTER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is true that the Ministry is planning a digital employment exchange to enable job-seekers to know vacancies and job opportunities in various departments;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there are any plans to conduct exams in such a way that they do not clash with each other and job-seekers get an opportunity to appear in whichever exam they wish to attend; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) : The National Career Service (NCS) Project is a Mission Mode Project of Ministry of Labour & Employment for transformation of the National Employment Service to provide a variety of employment related services like career counselling, vocational guidance, information on skill development courses etc. through a web-based portal. The NCS services are available online on the National Career Service portal (www.ncs.gov.in) supported by multilingual Call Centre/Helpdesk and is accessible by all users. The NCS service can also be availed directly through the Employment Exchanges, Career Centres, Common Service Centres etc. In addition to the above procedure, advertisement of vacancies are to be mandatorily placed at the NCS portal which has been developed primarily to connect the opportunities with the aspiration of youth.

The Central Government recruitment agencies such as Staff Selection Commission, Railway Recruitment Board etc schedule the conduct of various examinations in such a way that they do not, as far as possible, clash with each other.
