- (a) whether military expenditure as a percentage of GDP has reduced over a period of time and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Government is not spending proportionately on operations and maintenance of military equipment and development of defence infrastructure; and
- (c) if so, the reasons therefor along with the details of the funds allocated for modernization and equipment in the last three years?

# (a) Budget Estimates (BE) under DSE is as under:

It may be seen from the above figures that Defence Expenditure as a percentage of GDP may appear to be decreasing due to increasing trend in growth of GDP however, Defence Expenditure is increasing every year in absolute terms.

- (b) The expenditure on operation / maintenance and Defence Infrastructure has been maintained optimally.
- (c) Details of capital budget which includes expenditure on modernisation and equipment for the last three years are as follows:
