PICTORIAL WARNING ON TOBACCO PRODUCTS

82. SHRI ANOOP MISHRA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the initiatives taken by this Ministry under the National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP) guidelines to ensure that all products manufactured in registered factories print the pictorial health warning;
- (b) the details of the monitoring mechanism implemented for the same and details of the cases being reported for noncompliance and action taken by the department since April 2016 till now, State-wise;
- (c) the details of the Bidi Rollers who have been sensitized about the health hazards of bidi rolling in coordination with Health Department during the three years, State-wise; and
- (d) the details of implementation of vocational training of bidi rollers for alternative livelihood opportunities and the number of bidi rollers benefited by the same during the said period, Statewise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

(a) & (b): The Ministry communicates to several Central Ministries/Departments viz. Revenue (Central Board of Excise and Customs), Civil Aviation, Tourism, Labour, External Affairs, Commerce, etc. and States/Union Territories about the notification of new health warning as and when it is notified and also provides soft copies of notified specified health warning to them for its compliance.

A provision has been made in National Tobacco Control Programme (NTCP) guidelines that Secretary Labour/Labour Commissioner or the Nominee (member of the State Level Coordination Committee), Sales Tax Officer & District Labour Officer (member of the District Level Coordination Committee) shall ensure that all tobacco products manufactured in registered factories print the pictorial health warning.

The onus of enforcing various provisions of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 (COTPA, 2003), lies with the States/UTs.

The details of the cases reported for non-compliance of the same and action taken in this regard since April 2016 till now are enclosed at **Annexure** – I.

(c) & (d): The Ministry of Labour and Employment has initiated a Skill Development Programme this year in coordination with this Ministry, World Health Organization, International Labour Organization, United Nations Development Programme and other Ministries for beedi workers. Through this programme, beedi rollers are also being sensitized about the health hazards of bidi rolling. Details of the beneficiaries under this programme are at **Annexure-I1**.
