- (a) the number of farmers from Rajasthan including Sri Ganganagar district whose agriculture land has been acquired for fencing at the Indo-Pak border in the year 2003-04 along with the area of land acquired separately;
- (b) whether there is any proposal before the Government regarding compensation for the aforesaid affected farmers and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to acquire the agriculture land that came under fencing for defence purposes and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to simplify the procedure of going across the fencing for farmers engaged in farming and thereby affected by the fencing?

- (a) to (c): Nil. No land has been acquired by Ministry of Defence in border districts of Bikaner, Sri Ganganagar, Jaisalmer and Barmer during 2003-04 for fencing at Indo-Pak border.
- (d) Government has made provision for fence gates at appropriate places to facilitate movement of farmers for farming purpose. The timing for opening / closing of fence gates are decided in consultation with local farmers as per their convenience.
