CCTV AT STATIONS

898. SHRI RAJESH KUMAR DIWAKER:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Railways has proposed to install CCTV surveillance system across 900 stations under the Nirbhaya Fund and if so, the details of stations, State/UT-wise;

(b) the funds allocated/approved to strengthen security at railway premises;

(c) the details of the funds allocated and utilised under the Nirbhaya Fund in the last two years and the current year including those provided to NGOs, zone-wise;

(d) the number of stations already equipped with CCTV cameras; and

(e) whether the Government is also planning to install CCTV cameras in all suburban railway stations to ensure safety of women and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS

(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. 983 Railway stations have been identified for installation of Close Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras

under the Nirbhaya Fund. Division wise details are Appended. Works to the tune of ₹ 413.36² crore (latest anticipated cost) have been approved under Integrated Security System to strengthen surveillance mechanism at 202 Railway stations over Indian Railways. Sanction of ₹ 500 crore has also been received for installation of Close Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras at identified railway stations under “Nirbhaya Fund”. Strengthening and upgradation of security infrastructure is an ongoing process. Need based allocation of fund is being made for creation of security related assets and procurement of plant and equipment (vehicles, baggage scanners,) etc. under Works Programme and Machinery and Plant Programme (M&P) of Railways each year.

(c): ₹ 50 Crore as mobilization advance has been given to RailTel for carrying out the work of provision of CCTV surveillances system at 983 Railway stations.

(d): About 394 railway stations have already been provided with CCTV cameras over Indian Railways.

(e): Suburban Railway Stations have also been identified for installation of CCTV cameras under Nirbhaya Fund.
