CONSTRUCTION OF OVERBRIDGE ON JALORE-AHOR ROAD

927. SHRI DEVJI M. PATEL:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to connect Jalore district with National Highway to facilitate transport service, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the construction of overbridge in place of existing level crossing no. C-48 on Jalore-Ahor Road (NH-325) is being delayed due to the paucity of funds, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total cost of the said overbridge; and
- (d) the time by which it is likely to be completed and if not, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Jalore district is already connected through National Highway (NH) No. 325 (Balotra-Siwana-Jalore-Ahore-Sanderao road) in the State of Rajasthan. The Detailed Project Report (DPR) for this National Highway has been prepared. As per DPR, development of this NH to 2 lane with paved shoulders has been envisaged in four packages on the Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) mode of execution. The work in the stretch from km 58.00 to km 91.60 and km 118.90 to km 156.95 of this NH has been awarded and the work started.
- (b) to (d) Level Crossing No. C-48 falls on the existing route of NH-325. At present, there is no programme for construction of overbridge in place of this existing level crossing.
