**REHABILITATION OF FAMILIES DISPLACED DUE TO FLOODS**

- (a) whether the Government has completed the process of rehabilitation and resettlement of the families displaced due to the recent floods and erosion in Assam and if so, the number/details thereof, location-wise and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (b) the quantum of funds allocated/ being allocated/released/utilised for the purpose?

(a) The Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Government of Assam has provided Rehabilitation Grant out of State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) fund to the families displaced due to recent flood & erosion. The details of number of families affected (District-wise) by flood and financial assistance provided out of Rehabilitation Grant are at **Annexure – A**.

The Rehabilitation Grant for 175 displaced families are in process and funds are being allocated by the State Government. The displaced families affected due to flood have shifted to their homes after closure of relief camps. The total number of relief camps and shelters set up were 960.

(b) The quantum of funds allocated/ being allocated/released/utilised for the purpose is as under :
