INSTALLATION OF TV TRANSMITTERS

931. DR. KIRIT SOMAIYA:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of TV transmitters (low and high) installed in the country, State-wise ;
- (b) whether the Government has chalked out any plan for installation of TV transmitters in various States;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, Statewise;
- (d) whether any time limit has been fixed for this purpose; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (e) Prasar Bharati has informed that Doordarshan has 230 High Power Transmitters (HPTs) (211 analog and 19 digital) and 801 analog Low Power Transmitters (LPTs) in its terrestrial TV network. Details of State/UT-wise HPTs & LPTs are given at **Annexure-I**.

As part of sanctioned 12th Plan schemes, 5 new High Power Transmitters are planned in J&K. In addition, 45 Digital Terrestrial Transmitters (DTT), at existing transmitter locations are also approved in various parts of the country. State/UT-wise list of these transmitters is given at **Annexure-II**.

Installation of DTT at Srinagar has been completed. The time schedule for completion for 5 digital ready analog HPT projects in J & K is about 2 years.

The DTT pilot is launched in 16 cities and remaining 44 DTTs have been planned after review of the technology.
