- (a) whether the Government has received the details of utilisation of Nirbhaya Fund from various States/UTs and if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Supreme Court has given any direction to the States in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of projects commenced, funds allocated and utilised so far, project, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the further measures taken by the Government for faster roll out of schemes thereunder?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SMT. MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI)

(a) to (d): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

(a) to (c) : Yes Madam, the project-wise, State/UT-wise details funds allocated and disbursed under Nirbhaya Fund is at **Annexure-I.**

Hon'ble Supreme Court vide Writ Petition (s) (Civil) No. (s). 565/2012 Nipun Saxena & ANR. VERSUS UNION OF INDIA & ORS. dated 09.01.2018 directed all the State Governments and Union Territories to file an affidavit indicating the amount received under the Nirbhaya Fund towards victim compensation, how much of that amount has been disbursed from the Nirbhaya fund and even otherwise and to the number of victims of sexual assault.

(d) The Ministry is regularly monitoring and reviewing the status of schemes with the States/UTs government for operationalization/ implementation. To faster rollout, the grants are being released to the District Collector/ District Magistrate directly under the scheme of One Stop Centre and Women Helpline.
