Will the Minister of **HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the students are facing problems in attending the National Eligibility and Entrance Test (NEET) due to shortage of centres as well as the locations of centres at far away places;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken/being taken by the Government to increase NEET centres in the country;
- (c) whether the Government also plans to conduct NEET and Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) twice a year to give an opportunity to the students to bring out their best performance; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO THE PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.*433 FOR ANSWER ON 26.03.2018 ASKED BY SHRI GAJANAN KIRTIKAR AND SHRI CH. MALLA REDDY, MP, LOK SABHA REGARDING NATIONAL ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRANCE TEST.

(a) and (b): The Central Board of Secondary Examination (CBSE), which conducts the National Eligibility-Cum-Entrance Test (NEET), has not received any such information. The CBSE has, however, increased the number of NEET Examination centres from 107 in 2017 to 150 in 2018. All the District Headquarters, where there were more than 4000 candidates in NEET-UG, 2017, Examination centres have been given for NEET-UG 2018. List of such centres is placed at **Annexure-I**.

(c) and (d) The Government has decided to setup a National Testing Agency (NTA) as a Society registered under the Indian Societies Registration Act, 1860 as an autonomous and self-sustained premier testing organization to conduct all entrance examinations for higher education institutions in the country. The NTA would initially conduct those entrance examinations which are currently being conducted by the CBSE. Other examinations will be taken up gradually after NTA is fully geared up. It will conduct examination in the online mode twice a year in order to give adequate opportunity to candidates to bring out their best, and develop Standard Operating Procedure (SOPs) for handling any glitches that may arise in the course of conducting online examinations. In order to serve the requirements of the rural students, it would locate the Centres at Sub-District/District level and as far as possible would undertake hands-on training to the students. NAT would conduct first set of examinations from the year 2019 onward.
