Branded Generic Drugs

*454. SHRI K. ASHOK KUMAR:

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Indian Pharmaceutical Industry earns major part of its revenue by selling branded generic drugs in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the generic drugs are cheaper than branded generic drugs and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is true that the generic drug is sold by its salt name, while the branded generic drug is sold by the company under a particular brand label; and (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI ANANTH KUMAR)

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFFERED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 454 FOR REPLY ON 27.03.2018

- (a): Yes. However, the Drug (Prices Control), Order, 2013 does not distinguish between branded generic drugs and generic drugs. However, based on the report of the All Indian Origin Chemists & Distributors Ltd.'s Advanced Working, Action and Correction System (AWACS), the total Annual Turnover of formulations for 2017 was Rs. 1,16,389 crores. It is understood that a major part of it is the share of the branded generic medicines.
- (b): Branded generic medicines are generally sold at higher prices in comparison to their unbranded generic equivalents. An illustrative list comparing the prices of some of the unbranded generic medicines sold at the Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendras and their branded counterparts is given at Annexure.
- (c) & (d): Yes. The generic drugs are sold under name as per Indian Pharmacopoeia, while the branded generic drug is sold by the company under a particular brand label along with the pharmacopoeia name (salt name) which is also required to be mentioned along-with the brand name.
