loyment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), 2005, the Central Government notifies MGNREGA wage rates every year for all States/UTs. The wage rates are revised and applicable from 1st April every year. The revision is based on Consumer Price Index for Agricultural Labour (CPI-AL).
