**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 566 BY SHRI BALABHADRA MAJHI REGARDING 'NATIONAL MISSION FOR GREEN INDIA' DUE FOR REPLY ON 06-04-2018.**

(a) & (b) The approved outlay for the National Mission for a Green India (GIM) for the period from 2017-18 to 2019-20 is Rs. 220.0 Crores. The release of funds depends on the year-wise budgetary allocation. The budget allocations for the years 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 are Rs. 72.0 Crores, Rs. 42.01 Crores and Rs. 47.80 Crores respectively. Against these budgetary allocations, the actual expenditure was Rs. 70.22 Crores, Rs. 41.62 Crores and Rs. 47.088 Crores respectively.

(c) The release of balance Central share is subject to availability of funds, progress of work and fulfilment of the conditions of release.
