- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and

(a) to (c) : Yes, Madam. Ministry of Road Transport and Highways formulated a scheme namely, "Development of Bus Terminals on BOT basis" for implementation during 12<sup>th</sup> five year plan. This scheme provides for financial assistance to engage Project Development Consultants for development of bus terminals on BOT basis. The Project Development Consultant cost is to be shared between Govt of India/State/UTs and successful bidder as per scheme guidelines. This scheme is yet to be appraised for continuation with completion of 12<sup>th</sup> five year plan.
