Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any company has been given contract for four laning of Jhansi-Mirzapur National Highway;
- (b) if so, the reasons behind non-commencement of above said work and the action taken against those agencies responsible for pendency of work; and
- (c) the measures taken by the Government to remove the factors responsible for such delays and details thereof?

- (a) to (c) Jhansi to Mirzapur National Highway originate from NH-25 and passes through NH-76, NH-75 and NH-7i.e. Jhansi - Deori – Chattarpur – Bamitha – Satna – Rewa – Mauganj – Hanumana – Mirzapur. The work of 4-laning of Jhansi to Bamitha has been awarded in two packages on Hybrid Annuity Mode in March, 2017. The appointed date of these works will be fixed after significant progress in land acquisition. The work of 4-laning of Bela to Rewa section of NH-7 is in construction stage. The section from Bamitha to Bela of NH-75 and Rewa to Hanumana of NH-7 is being developed to 4-lane by Madhya Pradesh Road Development Corporation.
