- (a) whether the Government has started constructing concrete roads, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the length of roads (in kilometers) constructed in the country during the last three years along with the expenditure incurred on it; and

- (a) Yes Madam , the concrete pavement is constructed on National Highways if found feasible based on Life Cycle Cost.
- (b) Ministry has constructed 18,702 km of National Highways with expenditure of 1,65,236.81 Cr including Internal and Extra Budgetary Resources (IEBR) during the last three financial years.
- (c) Targets and funds allocation are finalized on year to year basis.
