(a) Yes Madam , the concrete pavement is constructed on National Highways if found feasible based on Life Cycle Cost.

(b) Ministry has constructed 18,702 km of National Highways with expenditure of 1,65,236.81 Cr including Internal and Extra Budgetary Resources (IEBR) during the last three financial years.

(c) Targets and funds allocation are finalized on year to year basis.
