(a) to (f): Yes, Madam. There was a proposal to set up a Museum of Arts and Crafts in Mumbai to show case the collection of Air India. However, in view of in-principle approval of Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) for considering strategic disinvestment of Air India and its five subsidiaries and ongoing disinvestment process, the Air India Museum project has been put on hold.
