EMPLOYMENT UNDER MGNREGS

1132. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of workers provided employment under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during each of the last three years and the current year, State and gender-wise;
- (b) the wages paid to these workers during the said period, State and genderwise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to develop any system for creating awareness among the rural population about the said scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a): State/UT-wise details of number of workers provided employment and number of women workers provided employment under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the last three years and the current year as on 01.2.2018 are given at **Annexure-I**.

(b): Gender-wise wages are not paid under MGNREGA. State/UT-wise details of wage expenditure on workers under the MGNREGS during the last three years and the current year as on 01.2.2018 are given at **Annexure-II**.

(c)&(d): The Government is actively engaged with the State Government in establishing systems that ensure provision of work as per demand. To generate awareness about the provisions of the Scheme and to provide adequate employment opportunities to rural households under MGNREGS, all States/UTs have been requested to (i) initiate appropriate Information Education and Communication (IEC) campaigns including wall paintings for wide dissemination of the provisions of the Act, (ii) expand scope and coverage of demand registration system to ensure that demand for work under MGNREGA does not go unregistered, (iii) prepare plans in a participatory mode and approve them in the Gram Sabha, and (iv) prepare realistic labour budget by the State.
