**Display of Air Quality Index Value**

1209. SHRI P. NAGARAJAN:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has tied up with Delhi Police to display hourly Air Quality Index (AQI) value and health advisories on LED panels at traffic intersection;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the AQI value is likely to be displayed;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to implement such decisions in other metro cities and other important tourists destinations across the country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b) Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) has tied up with Delhi Police to display hourly Air Quality Index (AQI) value and health advisories on LED panels at traffic intersection. Air Quality Index & Advisory is being displayed on hourly basis at 50 locations in Delhi, where Delhi Traffic Police has installed Variable Message Sign (VMS) Boards.
- (c) & (d) There is no decision regarding implementation of such plan in other metro cities and other important tourists destinations across the country.
