# Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to send three lakh youths to Japan for on job training for 3-5 years as part of the skill development programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Japan has offered to bear the financial cost of the skill training of Indian technical interns in that country; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

- (a) & (b) The Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) has signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MoC) with the Ministry of Justice, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare of Japan on 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 at Tokyo, Japan. The purpose of this MoC is to transfer technical skills from Japan to India by advancing the Technical Intern Training Programme (TITP).
- (c) & (d) No, Madam. However, there is a provision of payment of stipend to the interns during the internship period from the implementing/ supervising organizations in Japan.
