Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish more Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises(MSMEs) for the overall development of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the incentives being provided to the budding entrepreneurs for establishing the MSMEs; and
- (c) the other steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

(a)&(b): "Raw Agarbatti Industry" is primarily a cottage type traditional industry in the unorganized sector. Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises extends support under Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programmes (PMEGP) to help them for setting up Agarbatti making centres.

During the year 2017-18 margin money assistance under this programme has been extended for 190 projects. State-wise details are at Annexure.
