PRIVATE DOCTORS FOR ESI HOSPITALS

1473. SHRI R. GOPALAKRISHNAN:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government proposes to hire doctors engaged in private practice to serve in Government-run Employees' State Insurance (ESI) Hospitals; and
- (b)if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) & (b): Yes, Madam, under Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948, there is provision to hire doctors engaged in private practice to serve in ESI hospitals on contractual basis in various specialities and super specialities. Such doctors are engaged on various posts lying vacant and paid consolidated remuneration based on number of hours service provided by them.
