Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to State:

- (a) whether the Union Government is due to release funds to States under Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the manner in which the States are utiliting the funds released under CAMPA and expenditure against the releases, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

- (a) & (b) funds are released to the State CAMPAs constituted in participating States/ UTs, in terms of the Order dated 10th July 2009, and judgement dated 12th march 2014 of the Hon'ble supreme court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995: T N Godavarman Thirumapad Vs UOI & Ors. A statement showing the State / UT wise releases since the year 2009 is at Annexure-A.
- (c) the funds are released to the States / UTs from Compensatory Afforestation Fund of the State managed by Ad-hoc CAMPA as per the annual plan of operation approved by the Steering Committee of State CAMPA. The activities undertaken includes compensatory afforestation, soil and moisture conservation, catchment area treatment, wildlife management plan and allied activities etc.
