- (a) whether the Government has received requests from the State Government of Maharashtra to release the funds for completion of ongoing/proposed work under the Vidarbha Intensive Irrigation Programme;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the total funds allocated, released and to be released by the Government;
- (c) whether it is true that the sanction and release of funds is long pending with the Government; and
- (d) if so, the present status thereof and the time by which the funds will be released by the Government?

(a) to (d): Vidarbha Intensive Irrigation Development Programme (VIIDP) was implemented as a sub-schemes of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) from 2012-13 to 2015-16 out of 20% of annual allocation earmarked for implementing programmes of national priority as sub-schemes since no budget allocation was provided for implementation of this scheme in the Union Budget 2012-13. Implementation of VIIDP as a sub-schemes of RKVY has been discontinued from 2016-17 onwards. An amount of Rs.825 crore had been allocated for implementation of VIIDP as a sub-scheme of RKVY during this period against which Rs.675 crore was released.
