(a) & (b): At present four BG rail connectivities are operational on Indo-Bangladesh Rail Route viz., Gede (India) - Darsana (Bangladesh),
Petrapol (India)-Benapol (Bangladesh ), Singhabad (India) - Rohanpur (Bangladesh) and Radhikapur (India)-Birol (Bangladesh). Freight trains run via all these routes. Two passenger trains viz., Kolkata-Dhaka,
Maitree Express runs via Gede (India)-Darsana (Bangladesh) and Kolkata-Khulna, Bandhan Express runs via Petrapole (India)-Benapole (Bangladesh).
