INSTALLATION OF CCTV CAMERAS

1989. SHRI P. NAGARAJAN:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to install CCTV cameras in 11,000 trains and around 8500 railway stations across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total expenditure to be incurred for CCTVs installations; and
- (d) the source of income for the said proposals?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI RAJEN GOHAIN)

- (a) & (b): All Railway Stations and passenger carrying trains are planned to be provided with CCTV based surveillance system.
- (c) & (d): Ministry of Railways has proposed to provide CCTV based surveillance system in passenger carrying trains and balance stations using Nirbhaya Fund at a total cost of around ₹ 3770 Crore. Based on the availability of the funds, this work will be taken up.
