199. SHRI MUTHAMSETTI SRINIVASA RAO (AVANTHI):

Will the Minister of AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH) be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is planning to set up two world class AYUSH hospitals in Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh to promote the use of the Indian systems of medicine;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the details of budget earmarked for the purpose; and

(d) the time by which the said hospitals/ institutions are likely to be completed?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

(a) to (d): Health is a State subject. Opening of AYUSH hospitals in the States/ Union Territories comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is a provision of setting up of 50 Bedded Integrated AYUSH Hospital. Central Government has approved Rs. 533.33 lakhs each for setting up of two upto 50 Bedded Integrated AYUSH Hospitals at Theni District and Thiruvannamalai in Tamil Nadu during 2016-17. Further, one upto 50 Bedded Integrated AYUSH Hospital at Kakinada was approved during 2014-15 for which Rs. 228.85 lakhs has been sanctioned till date and another one upto 50 Bedded Integrated AYUSH Hospital at Visakhapatnam was also approved during 2016-17 for which Rs. 168.85 lakhs has been sanctioned till date in the State of Andhra Pradesh. Implementation of approved projects comes under purview of State/UT Governments.
