**Reconstruction of Flood Affected Areas**

2017. KUNWAR BHARATENDRA:

Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of progress made in respect of reconstruction of flood affected areas in Assam, Nagaland, Manipur and Mizoram;
- (b) whether any steps are being undertaken to reduce flood damage/erosion in the upcoming monsoon; and
- (c) if so, the budget outlay provided for the proposed measures?

(a) to (c) The required information is not centrally maintained. The subject of flood management, including erosion control, falls within the purview of the States. The flood management and anti-erosion schemes are planned, investigated and implemented by the State Governments with own resources as per priority within the State. The Union Government supplements the efforts of the States, *inter alia*, by providing technical advice and promotional financial assistance for management of floods in critical areas.
