#### AIIMS REST HOUSE IN DELHI

#### 21. SHRI P. NAGARAJAN:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) has decided to set up a 280-bed rest house/dharmashala for out-stations patients and their relatives to stay in Delhi for medical treatment;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the time by which the said rest house will be operational; and
- (c) the procedure and eligibility to get admission in the proposed dharmashala along with budget estimate for the same?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (c): Yes. A 280 beds Vishram Sadan, Namely, Power Grid Visram Sadan has been set up in Jai Prakash Narayan Apex Trauma Centre (JPNATC), All India Institute of Medical Schences (AIIMS), New Delhi and operationalized on trial basis w.e.f. 15/01/2018. The bed/rooms in Power Grid Vishram Sadan is allotted to the patient/their attendant on the recommendation of treating doctor of the AIIMS, New Delhi, through a centralized allotment system on normal charges.
