**CONVERSION OF NHs**

2177. SHRI LAXMAN GILUWA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has considered/is considering to convert National Highways No. 75 E into four lane;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor and the reaction of the Government thereto?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) As per the extant policy of this Ministry, National Highways having traffic more than 10,000 PCUs per day are to be 4-laned based on the outcome of Detailed Project Report (DPR). Stretches of NH-75E are in various stages of progress for development including their 2/4-laning. About 103 km of NH-75E in the State of Madhya Pradesh is under implementation for 4-laning.
