SETTING UP OF NEW THERMAL POWER PLANTS

2200. SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI:

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

(a) whether his Ministry has decided to set up new thermal power plants only within 500 kms of coal fields;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the manner in which this move will help to battle coal scarcity at power plants across the country?

(a) to (c): As per Electricity Act 2003, 'Any generating company may establish, operate and maintain a generating station without obtaining a licence under this Act if it complies with the technical standards relating to connectivity with the gird.

However, setting up a coal based Thermal Power Plant near a coal mine is beneficial as it saves on coal transportation cost and lowers the cost of generation.
