**AYURVEDIC HEALTH FACILITIES UNDER CGHS**

**229. SHRI RAKESH SINGH:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide Ayurvedic health facilities to the employees under the Central Government Health Scheme in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether any demand for providing Ayurvedic medical services in the existing dispensary at Jabalpur under the above scheme has been received; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

- (a): CGHS is already providing Ayurvedic Health facilities to the employees under the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) in the country.

- (c): Yes; demands to open Ayurvedic medical services at Jabalpur under CGHS have been received from various quarters.
- (d): A proposal for opening of new Ayurvedic Centres under CGHS including at Jabalpur is under examination in this Ministry.
