**Restoration of Sharing Pattern between Centre and States**

**2401. SHRIMATI RITA TARAI:**

**Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:**

**(a) whether the Union Government considers of restoring the earlier sharing pattern for the Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSSs) to enable the States to have more resources for their State schemes; and**

**(b) if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) & (b): Based on the recommendations of the Sub-Group of Chief Ministers, after the approval of the Cabinet, NITI Aayog vide its O.M. No. O-11013/02/2015-CSS & CMC dated 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 has issued instruction for revised funding pattern of Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS). Following the recommendations of the Fourteenth Finance Commission, devolution of resources from divisible pool of revenues has increased by 10%, from 32% to 42%, thereby putting significant resources at the disposal of the State Governments for scheme/project implementation. As such, there is no proposal for further restoring the earlier sharing pattern.**
