THE STATE DETAILS STEPS TAKEN BY ARCHAEOLOGICAL SURVEY OF INDIA (ASI) IN RESPECT OF THE TEMPLES/HISTORICAL SITES WHICH ARE SUBMERGED IN LAKES/RIVERS

SI. No State

Name of the site and the Project associated with it

Madhva Pradesh

- Samadhi of Srimant Baji Rao Peshwa-I, Raverkhedi, District 1. Khargone is coming under the submergence of Maheshwar Project. It is envisaged to construct a retaining wall around the monument to save it from submerging in water.
- In the year 2003-07 the temple of Choubis Awtar, Mandhata. 2. District Khandwa was transplanted to a different locality which was coming under the submergence construction area of Omkareshwar dam.
- 3. ASI carried a small scale excavation in the year 1987-88 at Balikeshwara, a medieval temple site situated on the left bank of river Narmada with a view of establishing the cultural sequence of the site before its submergence due to the Indira Sagar Project across the Narmada.
- In the same project the ASI carried out a small scale 4. excavation at Chandel, Dist. East Nimar (Khandwa) with a view to exposing the plan of temple and to ascertain earlier phases. The temple facing west and dedicated to one of the Saptamatrikas-Chamunda is situated on the western outskirts of the village Chandel in the Khandwa Taluk.
- Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) has received a request Himachal Pradesh 5. from the Department of Language, Art and Culture, Government of Himachal Pradesh for relocation of a group of Temples submerged in Bhakra Dam reservoir (Govind Sagar Lake) at Bilaspur, District Bilaspur (H.P.) and to declare them as monuments of national importance. ASI is presently looking into the feasibility of the project.
- 6. ASI documented monuments and historical sites that were Andhra Pradesh prone to submergence in low lying areas of river banks in the area. The sites which were documented are:
