CLCSS FOR MSMEs

253. SHRI RAVNEET SINGH:
DR. P. K. BIJU:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS) of the Government to encourage technology up-gradation of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) is in continuation and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Ministry is monitoring the work of Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI), responsible for the implementation of the scheme, with regard to their effectiveness to ensure easier credit facility to MSMEs; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with the outreach program with banks and MSMEs to provide such credit including the credit provided to the MSMEs during the last two years and the current year, state-wise, month-wise and segment-wise?

ANSWER

(a): Yes, Madam. The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises is operating a Scheme namely "Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (CLCSS)" for technology up-gradation of micro and small enterprises. The Scheme aims at facilitating technology up-gradation by providing capital subsidy of 15 per cent (limited to maximum of Rs.15.00 lakhs) on institutional finance availed by the micro and small enterprises to support induction of well-established and improved technologies in the specified sectors. Maximum limit of eligible loan for calculation subsidy admissibility under the Scheme is Rs.100.00 lakh.

(b) & (c): SIDBI and other implementing agencies have been given operational guidelines. The information on flow of credit under CLCSS is received in the Ministry of MSME regularly.

State-wise credit flow to the MSEs under the CLCS Scheme during last two years and the current year (upto December) has been indicated in the annexure.
