Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is taking any concrete steps to improve the functioning of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) in the light of deteriorating standards of professional technical education in private sector;
- **(b)** if so, the details thereof;
- **(c)** whether any steps are being taken by the Government to make a transparent mechanism at AICTE for recognition and monitoring of private institutions; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The Government and AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education) have taken concrete steps to improve the functioning of AICTE on the recommendations of Kaw Committee viz. to concentrate on mentoring and development, to focus attention on research and innovation, rating to be the fulcrum of regulation etc. The Committee submitted its report titled "Technical Education in India: A Futuristic Scenario" on 12.06.2015. The AICTE has implemented e-Governance mechanism which includes Online approval process for the institutes, dashboard and online grievance redressal system for eliminating corrupt practices and maintaining transparency & presenting model curriculum.
