- (b) if so, the proposes made in this regard; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) The Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government employees including Defence and Para–Military personnel by providing a common programme of education. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories Administrations thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as the availability of necessary sanction of the Government.

(b) KVS has informed that no such proposal in the prescribed format has been received from the District Administration, Buldhana, Maharashtra for opening of a new KV.
