- (a) whether Swarn Giri Fort situated at Jalore, a protected heritage monument since 1956 is now on the verge of extinction because of formalities being done in the name of protection by the Archeological Survey of India and in the absence of proper maintenance and if so, the details thereof
- (b) the total budget allocated and the amount spent on the maintenance of the protected monuments in the country including Rajasthan during the last three years;
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to develop said fort as a major tourism centre and to provide basic facilities in this fort; and
- (d) whether the Government is considering to construct approach road to reach this fort situated at height of two thousand stairs and make the access easy for tourists?
