UPGRADATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE ON BORDER

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the upgradation of infrastructure on the Indo-Pak border to control smuggling of narcotics has been completed;
- (b) whether the infrastructure upgrade of Border Observation Posts (BOPs) has helped in seizure of illegally smuggled narcotics so far;
- (c) whether the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Home Affairs for expedited construction of lateral and axial roads in Punjab has been accepted; and
- (d) if so, the details and status thereof?

- (a) & (b): Upgradation of infrastructure work on Indo-Pakistan border is a continuous process. The infrastructure upgrade of Border Observation Posts (BOPs) has helped in seizure of illegally smuggled narcotics.
- (c) & (d): Yes Madam. A draft note seeking approval of the Cabinet Committee on Security for construction of lateral and axial roads in the States of Punjab and Rajasthan is under process.
