MULTI-SKILLING INSTITUTES IN TRIBAL DISTRICTS

(a) whether the Government plans to set up multi-skilling institutes in tribal concentrated

districts;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and specially in Maharashtra State; and

(c) the steps taken by Government to build a framework suited to the various skill needs and

requirements of tribal people?

(a) to (c): There is no plan of Ministry of Tribal Affairs to setup multi-skilling institutes meant

only for tribal concentrated districts. However, Ministry of Skill Development and Enterprise has

planned to set up 1500 Pradhan Mantri-Multi-Skilled Industrial Training Institutes in unserved

blocks/underserved areas with active participation of Industry/Private partners. The proposed

institutes are planned in unserved blocks/underserved areas across country including tribal

concentrated areas. The scheme has been formulated in consultation with all ministries including

the Ministry of Tribal Affairs and is under the process of Government approval in Ministry of Skill

Development and Enterprise.
