GDP GROWTH

3156. DR. ANSHUL VERMA:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the rate of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) growth in the country has been on a rise and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the details of the growth rate of services, manufacturing, mining and agriculture respectively in the last quarter i.e. October-December, 2017; and**
- (c) the details of the GDP growth of the country during the above quarter (October-December, 2017)?**

ANSWER

(a): As per Second Advance estimates of National Income, 2017-18 and Quarterly estimates of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the third Quarter (Q3) of 2017-18 released on 28th February, 2018 by the Central Statistical Office (CSO), quarterly growth rates of GDP during last one year at constant (2011-12) prices and current prices measured in terms of growth over the same quarter of the previous year, are given below:

(b) & (c): As per the Second Advance estimates of National Income mentioned in part (a) above, Gross Value Added (GVA) growth rates of services, manufacturing, ‘mining & quarrying’ and ‘agriculture, forestry & fishing’ sectors along with GDP growth during the last quarter i.e. October- December of 2017-18 at constant (2011-12) and current prices are given below:
