(a) to (c): 46 Radar Stations have been established by the Indian Coast Guard along the Indian coastline, under coastal surveillance network (CSN) project, to achieve electronic and optical surveillance of areas of high sensitivity and high traffic density.

(d) The total number of posts lying vacant in Indian Coast Guard are 2368. Out of these posts, 429 belongs to officer cadre and 1939 belongs to non-officer cadre.
