**KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA IN JABALPUR**

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has received any complaints with regard to the Kendriya Vidyalaya under the Tropical Forest Research Institute (TFRI) located at Jabalpur district in Madhya Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has taken any steps to resolve the problem of the Kendriya Vidyalaya; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the future roadmap for the same?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that one teacher of Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV), Tropical Forest Research Institute (TFRI), Jabalpur has raised the issue of late payment of salary to the staff of that KV from the month of May, 2016 onwards stating that they are facing financial hardship.

(c) & (d) KVS continuously pursued the matter with the sponsoring project authority, i.e., TFRI, Jabalpur which is liable to bear all recurring and non-recurring expenditure as per the terms and conditions agreed upon by them at the time of opening of the KV. After follow-up action by KVS, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, vide letter dated 8.12.2017, has issued directions to the TFRI authorities to provide the necessary budget to KV TFRI, Jabalpur.
