ADDITIONAL FUNDS REQUIREMENT UNDER MGNREGS

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether his Ministry was in the process to secure more funds to meet the additional requirements under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to allocate a sum of Rs.10,000-12,000 crore for MGNREGS; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): The Government has increased the budget provision for Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) over the years. During FY 2017-18, Rs 55,000 crore has been allocated for MGNREGS, which is highest ever budget allocation since inception of the Programme. The fund release for implementation of MGNREGA to States/UTs is a continuous process and Central Government is making funds available keeping in view the demand.
