(a) to (c): Airports Authority of India has already formed a Design Council consisting of eminent Architects, Head of Department of College of Architecture, Artists and eminent personalities to guide the Project Management Consultation in incorporating local design features, elements in new Terminal Building design. One Design Council member is associated with each project to review and finalize the concept and design of the New Passenger Terminals so that it connects with the local population and reflects the unique identity and culture of the state and the local area.
